





DUANE AND BITA LYONS, DELIVERING CUTTING-EDGE TECHNOLOGY TO THE WORLD

Your Los Lagos neighbors have some amazing new technology to share with you!

hen you or your loved ones are in need of medical care, nothing is more important than communication with your doctor and receiving attention as soon as possible.

Providing an immediate connection between patients and their physicians is so important to Bita Lyons that she is the originator of $LEO360^{\tiny{\text{TM}}}\text{, a}$ full-size robot that is a sophisticated tool enabling physicians and medical staff to connect with patients remotely, access medical information, and perform medical examinations virtually. LEO360 can provide 56 diagnostics, including modules to measure blood pressure, pulse rate, temperature, blood glucose level, blood oxygen level, and weight. It can also do much more with diagnostic preferences such as dermatoscope, electrocardiograph, otoscope, spirometer, stethoscope, and ultrasound.

"Bita is definitely the brains behind LEO360," said **Duane Lyons**, Bita's husband. "She began working in the digital health industry more than 18 years ago and has such vision in Artificial Intelligence for healthcare decision-making and so much more."

Together, the couple formed Lyons Global[™], a company headquartered in Granite Bay and recently expanded into the UAE and Turkey. Duane is the chairman, president, and CEO, and

Bita is the chief innovation operating officer. The mission of Lyons Global is to "provide easy-to-use, adaptable, and accessible products that can expand the geographical reach of healthcare delivery," according to Duane.

Both Duane and Bita are experts in the field, with Duane boasting 47 years of experience as a businessman, investor, financier, speculator, real estate entrepreneur/developer, and manufacturer expert. Bita has been developing robots and telemedicine platforms since 2006.

"Since I began my journey in healthcare, I noticed flaws in doctor-controlled telemedicine technology," Bita said. "Because of all these flaws, Duane and I decided to create a doctor-controlled robot to save time and improve efficiency for both doctors and patients."

Bita said her focus has been on spearheading innovation in U.S. healthcare and extending her impact globally. Bita's influence reaches 311 hospitals and 2,338 clinics, impacting the lives of 21.6 million patients.


Armed with an MBA in Health Industry Leadership from Regis University, along with executive education from MIT and Harvard Medical School, Bita is currently studying to receive her Doctorate of Business and Global Health from California Intercontinental University in Irvine, California.

Recently, the LEO360 platform has been trialed at the Reproductive Fertility Center in Southern California. Dr. Susan Nasab, a reproductive endocrinology and infertility subspecialist and global executive medical director of Lyons Global, and her team, including 19 staff members, provided telehealth services using the LEO360 platform. During the trial, they were able to save significant physicians' and patients' travel time and distance. They are planning to use LEO360 Robot in their Beverly Hills location as the second phase of the trial.

"LEO360 is one of the most comprehensive tools," Dr. Nasab said. "With LEO360, our patients don't need to wait for appointments. They can easily connect with their doctors for most matters."

LEO360 is a fully HIPAA-compliant platform that offers multiple options, such as patient registration, patient, and staff scheduling, and receiving and sending tasks and reminders. LEO360 allows the provider to obtain history and document the physicians' notes while performing a video/audio consult. In addition, the provider and patient can invite other family members to the visit or add other staff to the consultation session at any time. Live-to-text and screen sharing during consults are among the other options that LEO360 has added to this cutting-edge technology.





years of providing telemedicine services on robotic platforms said: "The capabilities built into LEO truly stand out. It allows me to care for my patients from a distance, but with this technology, it feels like I am right at their bedside."

In addition to Southern California, LEO360 has also been trialed in Turkey at The ACIBADEM ALIFE Healthcare Center, a long-term care facility that can accommodate up to 27 patients. According to a pilot study at the center, using LEO360 medical AI robot reduced the time needed for the physicians to arrive at the patients' bedsides. The study determined that the average time for a physician to connect to a patient at the bedside depended only on the time needed to move the robot into the patient's room, saving minutes or hours. The first doctor who used LEO360 Robot in Turkey said, "I can sleep at night without having to worry about not being able to take care of my patients right away." That is the real heart of the Robot, that even the doctors who live two hours away in traffic can ease their minds because they can get a simulated bedside exam within seconds to minutes.

During the implementation of the first Robot in Turkey, the transformation of the care delivery model was outstanding. The specialist Dr. Ahmet, who didn't want to participate in the pilot program,

became one of the biggest supporters and said, "I was skeptical at first; I didn't see the need for a robot in medicine. But after I saw how effortlessly I could interact with my patients remotely, how I could listen to their heartbeats as if I were right there with them, my view changed. I'm an emotional doctor; I need to connect with my patients. This device lets me do just that, even when I'm not physically present. It's like being there without being there. The nurses called LEO "Dr. Ahmet is walking here". They saw LEO as part of their team.

Bita shared warmly, "Seeing the smiles light up patients' faces as LEO walks into the room, and they start talking with their doctors fills my heart with the purest happiness. It's a fulfillment of my goal, knowing that I've been able to contribute to helping patients through my knowledge."

Bita shared: "God has blessed me with Duane. He has always been the one urging me to reach for the stars, never letting me forget the dream to make a difference in this world, one step at a time. As he always says "Never, Never, Never Give Up. God has a plan for us."

Also, my grandfather was the one who taught me the importance of education. Despite the loss of my father at a tender age, my grandfather guided me along the path of learning.

His lessons, etched deeply into my heart, laid the foundation for everything that was to come. Then came the pivotal moment when the VA brought me to the shores of the United States to make telemedicine programs for veterans. During the amazing journey with each obstacle, I grew stronger, and more determined to make a difference. I can never forget my dearest mother-in-law whom I called "Mom" Elaine M. Lyons, a teacher by profession and a mentor by nature. Her words were like honey and her influence taught me the invaluable lesson of pursuing higher education and embracing fearlessness to have a voice and show your knowledge.

While Duane and Bita do spend countless hours working on their vision and making new applications for LEO360, they also enjoy their Los Lagos neighborhood that they have been a part of since 1996. Duane especially takes pleasure in collecting modern art from all over the world, which adorns their contemporarystyle home. They both like to cook and travel to exotic destinations. In Duane's free time, he enjoys mountain biking and rock climbing, especially on the climbing wall the couple had built in their home.

"I also like to play guitar, especially writing songs for Bita," Duane said.

Time for wine and dessert



Springtime for the Music Group and Granite Bay

In the Spring a young man's fancy lightly turns to thoughts of

Mozart and Scarlatti, anyone? Perhaps not quite what Alfred, Lord Tennyson was thinking of when he penned those immortal thoughts, but it works here in Los Lagos. At least **Ted Garelis**' fancy has been turning quite a bit to that angelic cherub, Wolfgang Amadé Mozart, for the past year or so while he learned the first movement of the boy genius' Fifth piano sonata in G major, Opus 283. Mozart was only 18 when he wrote this lovely sonata, and was already an experienced opera composer, working at the same time on his ninth opera, *La finta giardiniera*. At that age, the undersigned was struggling to graduate from San Ramon Valley High School. Are we all ready for the second movement? Maybe in 2025.

Next up at the Yamaha was **Karyl Villa** with the very delicate, dreamlike *Cristofori's Dream* by David Lanz, whose music is rather similar to that of Jim Brickman (a favourite of Karyl's): beautiful, relaxing, inspiring music. Mr. Lanz is another one of these busy young folk like Mozart who are always composing and performing professionally. Mr. Lanz is from the Seattle area and he began his professional endeavors in the Swingin' Sixties when he was in his 'teens. According to Karyl, *Cristofori's Dream* is about Bartolomeo

Cristofori, a harpsichord builder and the inventor of the piano. Additionally, it is one of Mr. Lanz's favourites of his own compositions. Ralph Marcello had recommended this beautiful piece to Karyl. Thank you, Ralph - you were right, Karyl played it beautifully!

The Music Group spotlight then trained its sights on Bob Frassetto. Bob sang two songs, accompanying himself on the guitar. The first was Tom Paxton's 1964 hit The Last Thing on My Mind, based on an old well-known sea chantey The Leaving of Liverpool. Sea chanteys are a genre of folk music used to accompany rhythmical labour on large merchant marine vessels in the good ol' days. We shall meet another sea chantey later in the evening. Bob's next song was a hit by Roxy Music: More Than This, written by Roxy Music's lead singer, Bryan Ferry. Roxy Music is a sort of British boy band; parenthetically we note that Mr. Ferry was born in 1945. Apart from music, Mr. Ferry is noted for his apparently distinctive sartorial style. on the subject may contact the undersigned. We also note that Mr. Ferry used to date supermodel Jerry Hall, mother of several children of Mick Jagger. Mr. Ferry has been married several times and has dated members of the British aristocracy. Thanks, Bob! We hope you will join us again!

Our second guitarist of the evening was **Dennis Studebaker**, who is so good at encouraging the audience out of its collective shell and joining him on his pieces. His first song was *I Can See Clearly Now* by reggae and pop singer Johnny Nash, who early in his career was marketed as a rival to Johnny Mathis. Very much a singer, he acted in around five movies and television shows to very good reviews. Dennis' second piece was the beloved *How Great Thou Art*. The music is from an old Swedish folk tune. The original hymn was written in 1885 by the Swede Carl Boberg.

And then for something completely different: Florence Gustafsson joined us for Lascia ch'io pianga from George Frideric Handel's Rinaldo accompanied by Bill Morgan on the organ and Amanda Turkes on the violin. The prolific Mr. Handel was from Hanover. He wrote more than forty Italian operas for London, and when the English began to tire of his wonderful operas, he wrote almost thirty English oratorios on Biblical themes. Rinaldo was his first Italian opera for London. A spectacular work about the First Crusade, our heroine is Almirena, the daughter of the leader of the Crusade, in love with Rinaldo, who is the most valiant warrior of the Christian army and who rejoices in the gift of a soprano voice. Almirena has been kidnapped by the Saracen King of Jerusalem and an evil sorceress. "Let me cry over my cruel fate", weeps the unfortunate Almirena in a melody used several times by Handel. Many singers have performed this beautiful aria in concert and on recordings, including that esteemed mistress of the charms and graces of Handelian style, Miss Barbra Streisand. Florence sang beautifully (move over, Barbra), and the balance between Florence and Bill and Amanda was beautifully judged.

Next, a Gustafsson followed a Gustafsson. Florence's daughter, Elsa, introduced us to the music of Domenico Scarlatti with his keyboard sonata in E major, K.380. It is a one movement piece, and you can just hear the birds twittering away melodiously. Domenico (we shall refer to him in this rather informal manner to differentiate Domenico from his father Alessandro) was an exact contemporary of both Handel and Bach in that all three were born in 1685. Domenico, born in Spanish-ruled Naples (Italy, not Florida), is most widely known for his 555 keyboard sonatas - one wonders if he stopped at that point because 555 is a bit of a round number. Papa Alessandro is best known for his operas - he wrote over sixty musical dramas of one sort or the other. He was supported for a period of time by Queen Christina of Sweden, then resident in Roma. Papa Alessandro had a second son, also a composer, much less well-known than Domenico: Pietro Filippo Scarlatti.

Monica Crooks, accompanied by François Rambau, presented two pieces. The first was our second sea chantey of the evening, the famous *Oh, Shenandoah* and the second was the tragic *Ode to Billie Joe. Shenandoah* is an American folk song, but otherwise of uncertain origin. It appears to have originated with *voyageurs*, or fur traders, sailing down the Missouri river. There are many versions of the lyrics - some concern a romance between an American Indian maid and a fur trader. In these versions, the Indian maid is often the daughter of the Iroquois chief Shenandoah. By the mid-1800s, it was a full-fledged sea chantey, sung by sailors around the world.

Bobby Gentry's Ode to Billie Joe dates from 1967 and was quite well-known at that time. The undersigned always thought Billie Joe was the girl in this tragic tale; instead, we have learned that Billie Joe is the boy who jumps to his death off the Tallahatchie Bridge. Miss Gentry became quite a celebrity: she recorded with Glen Campbell and even had her own television show on England's BBC. She retired from public appearances in 1982 and has not been in the public eye since that time: no appearances, no recordings and no interviews. She is thought to be happily with us still and would be in her 80s if she is alive. It is not known where she lives.

François followed Bob and Monica's lead with a work song of his own: Nat Adderley's jazzy rendition of a jazzy Work Song. At least one source calls Work Song one of the greatest jazz compositions of all time. Mr. Adderley was a jazz trumpeter, and his younger brother was a jazz saxophonist, Julian "Cannonball" Adderley.

We missed Frank Andrews at the Music Group the previous month, but this month, like Dolly Levi at the Harmonia Gardens Restaurant, Frank was back where he belongs. Still glowin', still crowin', still goin' strong [1], Frank provided us with a bushel-load of great songs, proving yet again that the World is full of wonderful things. This month his back-up group consisted of Ralph Marcello, Dennis, Amanda and François. Frank and his group started off with a song from the 1921 Broadway hit Bombo: April Showers by Louis Silvers and George Gard "Buddy" de Sylva, as sung by the remarkable Al Jolson. Next up was Just in Time from the Broadway musical Bells are Ringing with music by Jule Styne and lyrics by Betty Comden and Adolph Green. Frank then presented us with Parla più piano from Nino Rota's score for The Godfather. Maestro Rota composed the scores for around 150 movies, including The Godfather and two Franco Zeffirelli movies: Romeo and Juliet and The Taming of the Shrew. Then the song without which no musical evening is complete, La Vie en Rose (Louiguy (Louis Guglielmi) and Édith Piaf). Frank continued with Has Anybody Seen My Girl? (Five Foot Two, Eyes of Blue). According to that fount of all received wisdom, the all-knowing Wikipedia, the derivation of the music and lyrics for this popular song is still a matter of dispute. Next was jazz standard The Tin Roof Blues, written and recorded by the New Orleans Rhythm Kings in 1923, one of the most recorded and most often played New Orleans Jazz compositions. Frank, et al. finished with the rollicking title song from Jerry Herman's Hello, Dolly! The title rôle was written for the Queen of Broadway, Ethel Merman, but she was busy with other projects at the time so Carol Channing had the honour of becoming the first Dolly in 1964. The Marm finally got her chance to have a meal at the Harmonia Gardens Restaurant six years later, when she closed the original Broadway run.

Then, the really important part of the evening: drink and food. We feasted on various cakes and ice cream. Solveig Gustafsson brought her delicious Mormor's mjuka pepparkaka, that wonderful soft gingerbread spice cake from her mother's recipe back in Sweden. Our attentive audience consisted of Chuck Foerster, Francine Foerster, Bonnie Carrick, Bengt and Solveig Gustafsson, Gary Young and Kathy Flossman, Mark and Bridget Lippsmeyer, Linda Briggs, Danielle and Kevin Petkus, Doris Strauch, Roxanne Colaw and Gretchen Thomas.





Father & Son, Dan and Daniel Marrujo

Barbecue up some mouthwatering ribs!

Dan and his son, Daniel Marrujo love soaking up that "father-son" bonding time. With rain pouring down outside, we turned our kitchen into a rib-cooking adventure zone and had an absolute blast! Here is the recipe we used:

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 racks of pork baby back ribs
- 1/4 cup brown sugar
- 1 tablespoon paprika
- 1 tablespoon garlic powder
- 1 tablespoon onion powder
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon black pepper
- 1/2 teaspoon cayenne pepper (optional, for some heat)
- 1 cup BBQ sauce (your favorite brand)
- Aluminum foil

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Preheat the oven: Preheat your oven to 275°F (135°C). w. Prepare the ribs: Remove the membrane from the back of the ribs. This can be done by sliding a knife under the membrane and then using a paper towel to grip and pull it off.

- 3. Make the rub: In a small bowl, mix together the brown sugar, paprika, garlic powder, onion powder, salt, black pepper, and cayenne pepper if using.
- 4. Apply the rub: Rub the spice mixture generously over both sides of the ribs, massaging it into the meat. Make sure to coat them evenly.
- 5. Wrap the ribs: Tear off two large pieces of aluminum foil. Place each rack of ribs on a piece of foil and wrap them tightly, sealing the edges.
- 6. Bake the ribs: Place the wrapped ribs on a baking sheet and bake in the preheated oven for 2.5 to 3 hours, or until the meat is tender and cooked through.
- 7. Glaze the ribs: Carefully unwrap the ribs and brush them with your favorite BBQ sauce, coating them evenly.
- 8. Broil the ribs: Turn on the broiler in your oven. Place the ribs back in the oven, uncovered, and broil for 3-5 minutes, or until the sauce is caramelized and slightly charred.
- 9. Serve: Once done, remove the ribs from the oven and let them rest for a few minutes before slicing between the bones and serving.

Enjoy your sweet and tender oven-baked ribs!



Our April Los Lagos Garden & Home Club meeting took us to the Wise Villa Winery located in the beautiful foothills of Lincoln. We had a group of 22 people enjoying this special event.

Wise Villa winery is a family owned and operated winery. Dr. Grover Lee, the owner, educated us on the different varieties of wine that he makes. The grapes are grown using organic and sustainable practices. Grover feels that the grapes need hills, granite soil, and a specific climate zone to grow correctly. The winery sits approximately at the 400-foot elevation. It has an inversion layer which prevents frost. It does not get as hot at the 400 ft. elevation in comparison to the valley floor. He gave us a tour of the wine facility and educated us on the process he uses to make his wines.

The first vintage was released in 2009. They have won many awards over the years. In 2015 they won the Golden State Winery of the Year, and in 2019 they won 27 medals. Every year they continue to win awards with their beautiful wines. I tasted their 2022 Sav Blanc. It was very crisp, fruity and light. Perfect for a hot day. I encourage you to do a wine tasting at the Wise Villa Winery, and to find your favorites.

The Winery includes a full-service Tuscan-style Gourmet Restaurant with both inside and outside seating. The members of the Los Lagos Garden & Home Club stayed after our tour and enjoyed wine tasting and a delicious lunch.
